Do the Author's Purpose Promenade

The Author's Purpose Promenade is a fun, and out of your seat activity for students to practice deciding the author's purpose of a text.. Each slide of this presentation is divided into 4 sections with a paragraph in the middle. Students will read the paragraph and then decide their answer. They then move to the corner of the room that matches that appropriate answer. After all students have decided and moved, you stop and have a quick discussion and then go on to the next slide! This is a fun and easy way to get the kids out of their seat, practice a necessary standard, and a way for teachers to quickly and easily observe their students' knowledge of the skill.

This activity includes an Exit Ticket that you can print off to give them to hand in when the activity is over.
