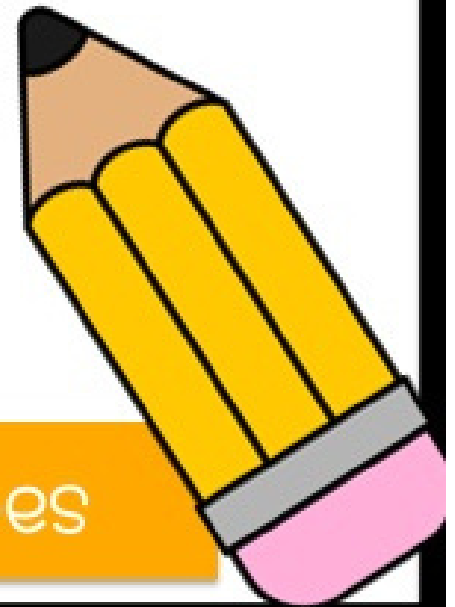

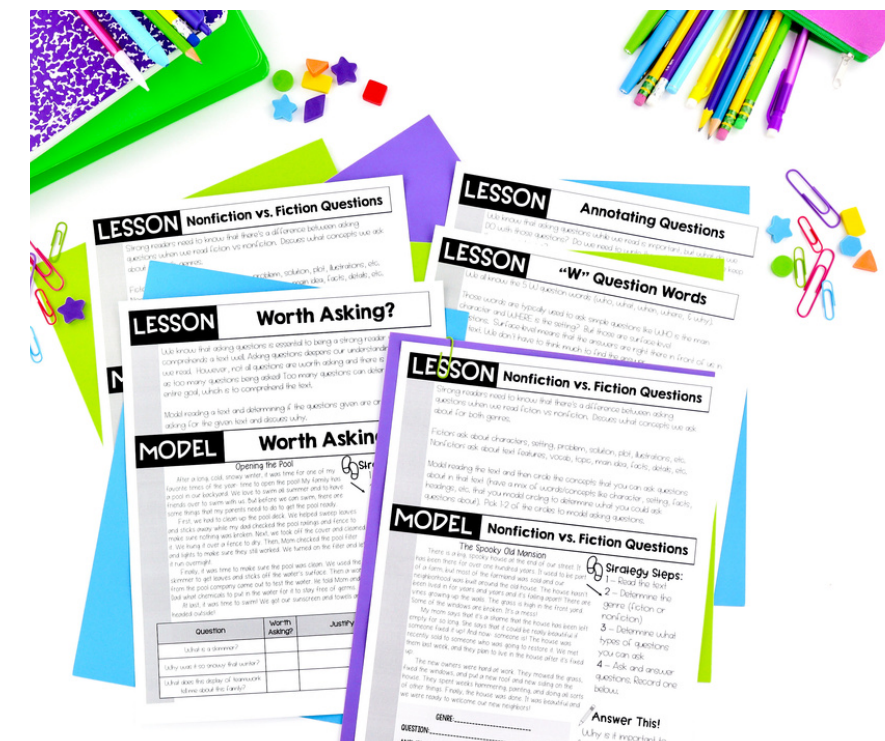
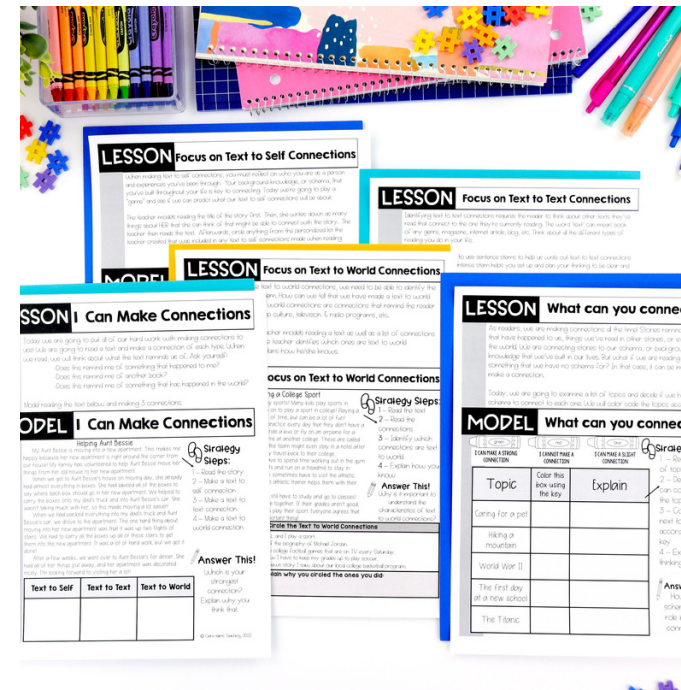

LESSON Mixed Up Plot

Today, I have an awesome challenge for us! We are going to see if we can put our knowledge of plot to the test. First, let's review the 5 parts of plot: exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, resolution. We are going to look at stories that have a plot—but they're all mixed up! Let's see if we can put them in the correct order and then tell what part of plot each one belongs to.

Ask Why is the order of plot important? How does it affect your understanding of a story?

MODEL Mixed Up Plot

Plot Parts:

- Exposition
- Rising Action
- Climax
- Falling Action
- Resolution

Story Pieces:

- So he decided to try to get over his fear of horses.
- Then, he petted and groomed the most gentle looking horse in the stable.
- First, he went out to the stables and just looked at the horses.
- Once upon a time, there was a king who was afraid of horses, but he needed to ride a horse to complete his duties around the palace.
- Finally, he sat on the horse's saddle and took a ride around the palace, having conquered his fear.

Strategy Steps:

- 1 – Read the story pieces.
- 2 – Review the 5 parts of plot.
- 3 – Match each part of plot to each bullet point.
- 4 – Put the story parts in order of plot.

2. How would the story be different if one piece was missing?

PRACTICE Mixed Up Plot

Plot Parts:

Story Pieces:

- We were afraid the balloon was going too fast and was going to crash!

- The balloon gently floated to the ground.
